Civic Life and Faith Study

As Christians, how might we best understand our role in the civic life of our nation? Our Lutheran perspective can help guide us. As the basis for our discussion we will be looking at a draft statement on "Civic Life and Faith." You can download the statement at www.elca.org/civicsandfaith. Please note that the entire document is 55 pages. We will focus on the first 11 pages. If you do not have a digital reader or printer, you can pick up a copy of the first section at the church. The remaining pages are background and deeper reading which may inform our conversation, but you do not need to have them for the conversation. This statement is in draft form, and we are invited to submit any feedback to the ELCA Task Force by September should we wish to comment.
